»THE CATHEDRAL OF MONET – FREEDOM IN PAINTING«

Contents

- Cylindrical 360° circular painting
- Painted original on 6 x 2 meters in oil on canvas, which is digitized in high resolution, enlarged, printed on fabric and staged as a 360° panorama
- Original painted in impressionist style
- The panorama shows Notre-Dame de Rouen Cathedral with its forecourt and surrounding alleyways and houses in the French city of Rouen at the end of the 19th century in a vibrant riot of colors ranging from orange to purple to pink
- Asisi based his work on a famous series of paintings by Claude Monet, who painted the cathedral several times under different lighting conditions
- Powerful panoramic staging
- The picture is revealed both from a close-up view at macro level and in its panoramic entirety from the visitor tower

Exhibition

- Exhibition of well over 200 works by Yadegar Asisi over a creative period of more than 30 years
- Examination of the tension between art and technology under the the influence of social achievements
- Use of various technical means: Painting, photography, digital art with the inclusion of AI models
- First digital collection with NFTs based on the original painting by Yadegar Asisi

- Exhibition of reproductions and originals, including the original of the panorama THE CATHEDRAL OF MONET on canvas

Technical details of the panorama

- one of the world's largest 360° panoramic paintings on a scale of 1:1
- Image area: approx. 3,500 m²
- Length: over 110 meters (approx. length of a soccer field)
- Height: approx. 32 meters (approx. height of a ten-storey house)
- Weight: around 650 kilograms
- Material: polyester, printed using the sublimation printing process
- approx. 4,750 meters of sewn yarn, i.e. roughly from the Panometer Leipzig to the Old Town Hall

Panometer Leipzig

- listed former gas storage facility of the Leipzig public utility company from 1910
- 34-meter-high cylindrical steel construction for hanging pictures
- In-house café
- Neighboring "Arena am Panometer" for open-air events
